Eight people work at the Monte Seixo and Serra do Cando wind farms (50 kilometres from Santiago de Compostela in northwestern Spain), which stand on an 800 hectare site. They maintain 97 wind turbines standing 55 metres tall with a total installed capacity of 100.21 MW.

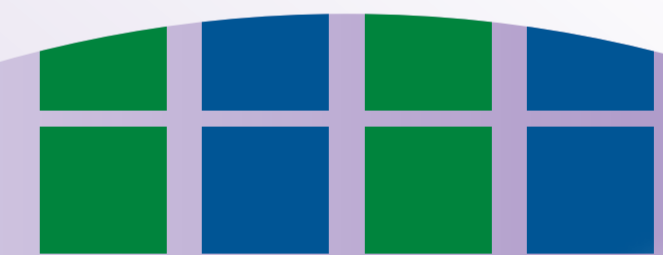
