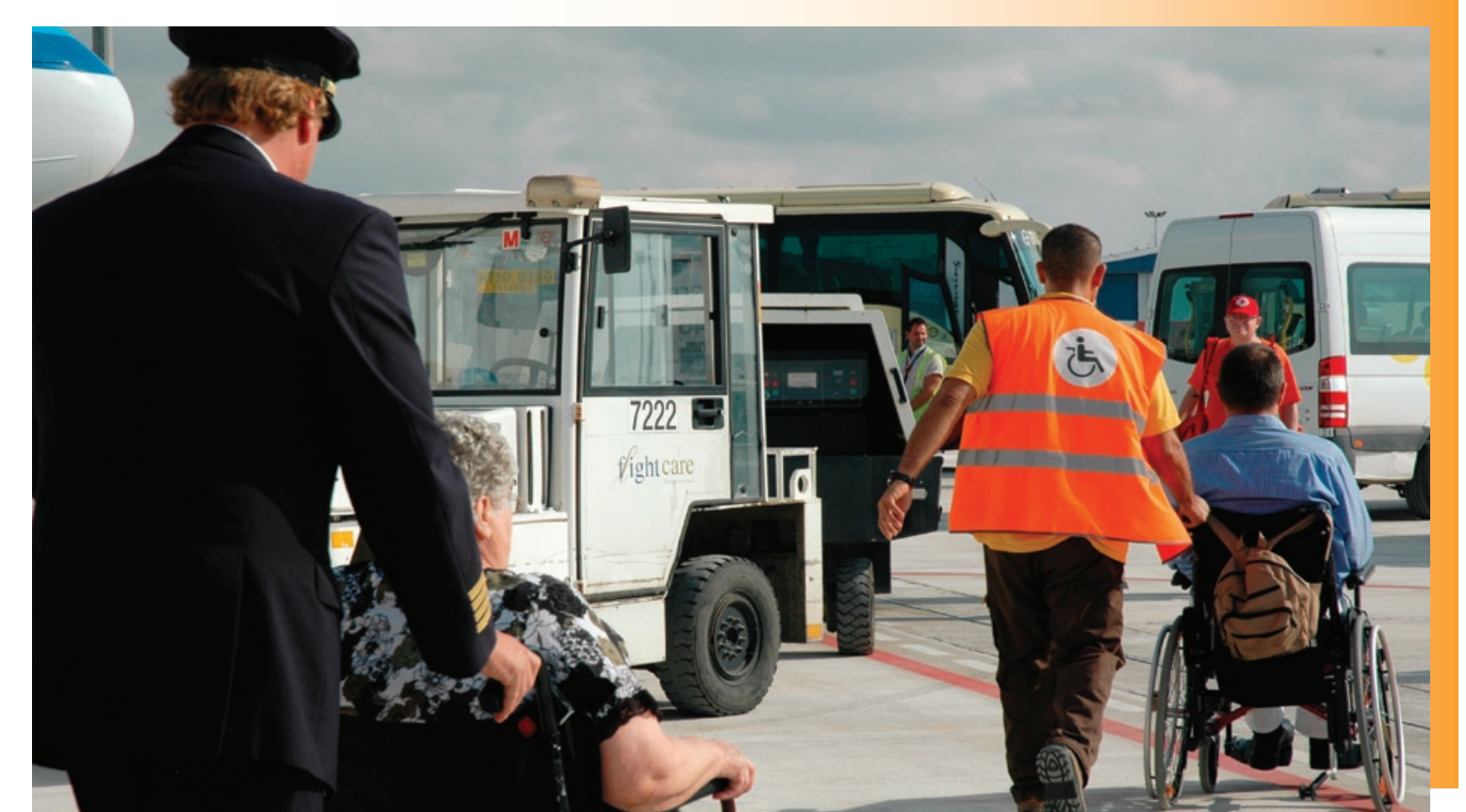
.A.S.A.: strong, reliable and well-positioned thanks to its employees' dedication
